GLOBAL VILLAGE – NETWORKING ZONE – STAND 422

What is it? A drop-in centre providing information and a meeting point for all those interested in workplace action.

What will it do? Offer guidance, materials, and the opportunity to exchange information on workplace policies and programmes, including labour legislation. Resource people will be available – from enterprises, trade unions, UN bodies, NGOs, donor organizations, and networks of positive workers.

Who is involved? It's coordinated by the ILO with a broad range of partners including organizations of employers and workers, and UN Plus, the support group for HIV-positive UN staff.

Where will it be? Stand no. 422 in the networking zone of the Global Village: a space for small group and one-to-one discussions, with materials to take away.

How will it work? No appointments – just drop in. Advice will be provided in English, Spanish and French. Topics covered include

- how to tackle discrimination at the workplace
- how to draw up a workplace policy and put it into practice
- how to carry out prevention at the workplace and encourage VCT
- how to provide care and support for affected workers
- how to reach out from the workplace to the community, including small and informal enterprises
