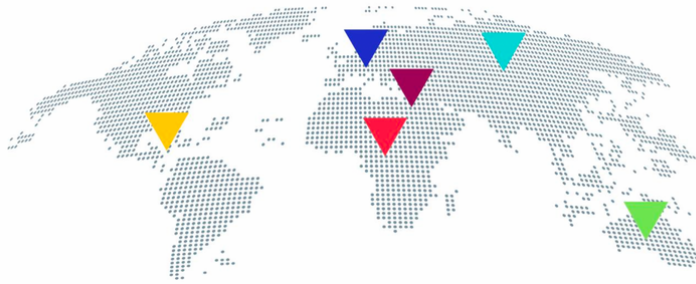

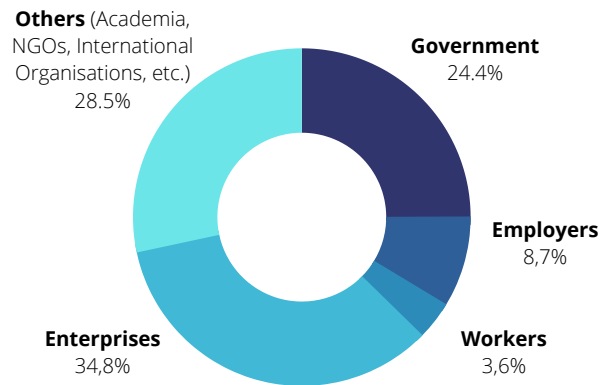

Type of organisation (participants of online courses)



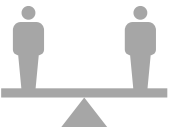

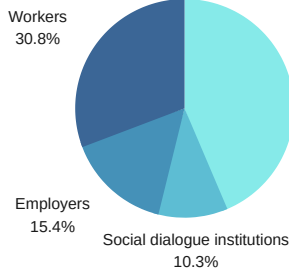
